We kindly ask you to **talk with your child at home** about choosing safe and friendly games and about how important it is to play respectfully and take care of one another.

At school, we are reinforcing these values through **class discussions, guidance lessons, and teacher supervision**. However, please be aware that any student who **participates in or encourages unsafe games** will face **severe disciplinary actions**, which may include being **excluded from special school events or trips**.

We will also continue to **recognize students who consistently show positive behavior and care for their peers**, as we believe that celebrating good choices builds a strong and respectful school culture.

**N.B** Make sure that your child is **connected to their Google Classroom**. This is an essential tool for class updates, learning resources, and practice activities that support your child's progress and engagement and **avoid losing grades** for missed submissions.
